## Catch this!

Make your own  
seed balls

### You'll need:

- ❁ Flower seeds
- ❁ Potter's clay powder, available at craft shops
- ❁ Peat-free compost
- ❁ Water
- ❁ Bowl
- ❁ Wooden spoon
- ❁ A baking tray

### What to do:

1. In a bowl, mix the seeds, clay, and compost together in a bowl to a ratio of three handfuls of clay, five handfuls of compost, and one handful of seed.
2. Slowly and gradually add water, you don't want it too gloopy. Mix it all together until you get a consistency that you can form into truffle-sized balls.
3. Place the balls on a baking tray and bake till dry in the sun for about 24 hours.
4. Toss your seed balls anywhere you would like to see flowers grow.
